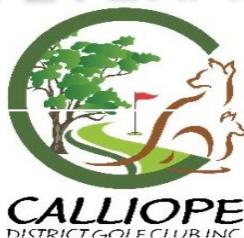

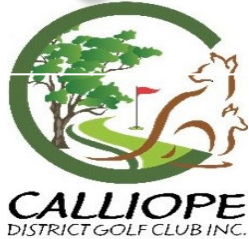

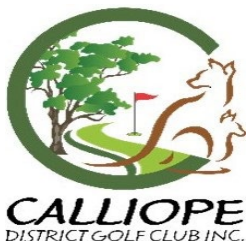

- 18 holes Stroke Gross Winners - Men - Divisions 1 & 2
- 18 holes Stroke Nett & R/Up Winners - Men - Divisions 1 & 2
- 18 holes Stableford Winners & R/Up - Men Division 3 & Ladies

All players must report to the bookings office in the Clubhouse Pro Shop at least 30 minutes prior to the hit-off time. The field may be limited and if requested, late nominations will be placed on a waiting list.

Tournament Rules

Note: This event is being played under the auspices of the Queensland Veteran Golf Association and Calliope District Golf Club Inc.

- Each competitor must be a financial member of a Veterans' Association or group and hold a current handicap with AGA or WGA
- The Calliope Vets Golf Club Committee reserves the right to alter or vary the program, divisional handicaps, or any event, if the number of competitors is deemed insufficient for a competition.
- The rules of golf in force at the time and the local rules of Calliope District Golf Club Inc. shall be the rules of the day. Should there be a dispute or doubt on a rule, a second ball should be played for that hole and a ruling sought later.
- The competition will be divided into two handicap stroke divisions and one stableford division for men and one stableford division for ladies.
- Your current daily handicap will be used for this competition.
- Each person can only win one overall divisional trophy. Should scores be tied, the result will be decided by count-back.
- Should play be stopped for any reason by the Committee, the completion of nine holes by ALL competitors (excluding retirees) is the criteria.
- QVGA membership cards to be available on request.

Pace of Play. Maximum Score. All stableford players, when you have run out of shots on a hole put a W in the score card and proceed to play the next hole. NOTE. This applies to all stableford players.

Golf Link cards may be necessary to register for play and may be required to be presented to the bookings Office on check-in. If not held, then a Handicap Card should be available for perusal.
